Obtaining a social security card

- A certified medical record stating your name and date of birth that has been signed by either a doctor or nurse from the facility can be used as evidence
- Unexpired valid U.S. driver's license
- Unexpired valid U.S. State issued I.D. card
- Valid and unexpired U.S. passport

The Social Security Administration does not print letters containing your social security number any more. It can take up to two (2) weeks for your new card to be delivered via mail. The SSA also does not accept the paper copy of your temporary I.D. card issued from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles. You must wait until you receive the actual card in the mail to use as proof of identity.

Obtaining an Indiana I.D. card or License

- If your address has not changed, you can receive a new one from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles if you have proof of your social security number. Proof can be your social security card or a 1099 form.
- If your address has changed, you need two (2) proofs of your new address like utility bills, lease agreement, computer generated mail, etc. These need to be current; not older than sixty (60) days.
- If you have never received an Indiana I.D. card, you need the following items: an official, stamped birth certificate, social security card or 1099 that has your social security number on it, and two (2) proofs of your current residence.
- If you cannot prove your residency and live with someone, they can fill out a residency affidavit. Those forms and further information can be obtained from either the local BMV or online at www.mybmv.com
